We offer an intensive hands-on AI course with a max of 7 students in any one course. By the end of day 3, all students will be fully versed in AI techniques and ready to put their new skills into practice on their own property or place of employment.

Please note that AI is a skill that requires ongoing practice in order to become proficient. This course is designed for breeders, or people who work in the cattle industry. If you are a hobby farmer or a farmer with a small herd, please give me a call to discuss the suitability of this course for your individual circumstances.

Where are we located?

We have a terrific *state-of-the-art* training facility on our property at Latimores Road, Burrell Creek, NEW SOUTH WALES about 10 minutes out of the quaint historic town of Wingham. The facility includes an airconditioned classroom for the theory and cattle bails built to the highest standard of safety for the hands-on practical.

How long is our course?

3 days, from 8.30am - 3.30pm.

What does our course cover?

The course is VERY hands-on and practical using live cattle, coupled with all relevant theory.

Topics we cover are as follows:

Insemination equipment

- Reproductive anatomy of the female cow
- Semen storage, handling and thawing
- Hygiene
- Diseases of importance
- Straw identification
- Semen inventory
- Heat detection
- Synchronisation
- Tank Care
- EBVs
- ABVs
- Handling Liquid Nitrogen safely

And the all-important SIX sessions of insemination practice with cattle.

How many students are in each course?

Maximum of 7 students. We limit numbers to small groups so that each student gets the most out of the training.

Are we approved and accredited?

Yes. Our course is animal ethics approved. Our NHIA accreditation number 295.

What is the cost?

\$1800 **plus** GST for 3 days. **Total cost \$1980.**

What about food and accommodation?

Students provide their own lunches. Tea coffee and biscuits are provided for morning and afternoon tea.

Q Fever Vaccinations

Q fever is an infection spread to humans from animals, mainly cattle, sheep and goats. It can cause a severe flu-like illness and long-term health problems. Vaccination is the most effective way to prevent infection and is recommended for all course participants.

Talk to your doctor to see if Q fever vaccination is right for you.

What are the course dates?

For the comfort of students and our cattle, we do not run courses over the month of February as it is too hot.

No Bull Cancellation Policy

We recognise that plans can change, however please be mindful that cancellations at short notice will likely incur a fee.

If you want to chat about options for cancelling or rescheduling a course, please contact us to discuss this further.

No Bull aims to be flexible and accommodating with training and recognises that in some cases, there are *exceptional circumstances* in which the fee may be waived.

We may be able to reschedule your training to another date if there is a compelling reason. Please note that 'work commitments' are generally not considered a compelling reason.

Please email us at *nobullab@gmail.com* to make any changes. We would prefer that all cancellations and reschedules are *initially made in writing.*

When is payment required?

Full payment of the final balance is required within 14 days of the invoice date. Invoices will be issued approximately 12 weeks before the course date.

If payment is not received within 14 days, we cannot guarantee your position on the course.

What happens if I have to cancel?

In the event of cancellation by the student, our policy is that a full refund will be given, provided we receive *notification of cancellation in writing a minimum of 21 days prior to the course date.*

For cancellations withing 7 -21 days of the course date, a 50% refund will be provided.

Or rather than cancel, you may transfer to the next available course date. As No Bull courses are often booked out 6-12 months in

advance, the next available course date may be the following year. Please note that there may be a course fee increase for the later course date.

What is the policy if I need to cancel 7 days (or less) before the course?

There is NO refund or rescheduling for cancellations received **less than seven days** prior to the course date.

There are NO refunds or rescheduling for any 'no show' on the day of the course.

If you are unable to make a course, you may however, transfer your booking to another person. This however, is **your** responsibility.
